

Proposal on Valletta parking

Entrepreneur Anglu Xuereb is proposing to re-excavate St Magdalene Ravelin, in front of the City Gate, to form part of the proposed embellished surrounding the new Valletta square.

He will be holding a public presentation on his proposal during a breakfast meeting open to the public, at the Palace Hotel on Wednesday at 0800h.

“The objective of this presentation is to address the shortage of parking spaces within Valletta and the main transportation network at the city entrance, as well as the pedestrian access following the proposed Renzo Piano project.



“As you may have noted a large number of car parking spaces for non-residents have been reduced and it is planned to reduce them even further. These include the Valletta residents’ scheme, St George’s Square, Freedom Square, Yellow Garage and St James Ditch.

“I believe that unless we address this drastic shortage, the business community will suffer immensely,” Mr Xuereb said.
