

Valletta reshaping

The former military services cipher block, located in the ditch below Ġlormu Cassar Avenue in Valletta, close to the entrance to the War Rooms, was demolished yesterday as part of the Grand Harbour Regeneration Project.

The single-storey building was built in the 1950s and housed the cipher operations of the British Mediterranean Fleet and later, Nato. It had been opened by Lord Louis Mountbatten.
