

Works on Valletta bus terminus commence

Traffic management arrangements come into force today with the commencement of works on the Valletta bus terminus, Transport Malta said.



- Triq Sarria, Floriana, from corner with Triq Vincenzo Bugeja up to corner with Triq I-Assedju I-Kbir, will be closed to vehicular traffic. Vehicular traffic will commute through Triq Sant' Anna, Floriana or through Sa Maison Hill.
- Scheduled route buses will access the Valletta terminus through Triq Sant' Anna and Vjal Nelson (currently used as an exit from the terminus). The bus stop located along Triq Sarria will be temporarily suspended. Public transport patrons are to make use of the bus stop along Triq Sant' Anna in the vicinity of the American Embassy.
- Vjal ir-Re Dwardu VII (the part in front of Fuq il-Biskuttin) will remain open to vehicular traffic.
- For the duration of the works, parking will not be permitted along Triq il-Mall from corner with Triq V. Dimech up to corner with Triq Vincenzo Bugeja and in the Pjazza E.S. Tonna area / Argotti Gardens. Triq il-Mall will remain open to through traffic.
- Access from Triq Sant' Anna to Pjazza San Kalcidonju (Archdiocese of Malta – Kurja Offices / Police General Headquarters / Balzunetta area) will be permitted through Pjazza E.S. Tonna and Triq Vincenzo Bugeja.
- The car park (located opposite the petrol station and adjacent to the Granaries) along Triq I-Assedju I-Kbir corner with Triq Sarria will remain open.
- The pedestrian walk-way along Triq I-Assedju il-Kbir (petrol station side) in the direction towards Triq Sant'Anna cannot be used for the duration of the works.
